### Application for a Minor Exemption

#### with regard to the Zoning By-Law No. 03-429 as amended

Notice is hereby given that during the regular council meeting of March 21, 2016 beginning at 7:30 p.m., the council of the Municipality of La Pêche will dispose of an application for a minor exemption with regard to the Zoning by-law no. 03-429 and its amendments for the following property: 895, Chemin Riverside. The purpose of the application is to allow the expansion of the existing building (drugstore) and the laying out of a driveway and parking area. More specifically, the application pertains to the following:

1. Reduce the waterfront setback with regard to a watercourse with intermittent water flow from 15 m to 9 m for the nearest corner of the proposed building addition;
2. Reduce the waterfront setback with regard to a watercourse with intermittent water flow from 15 m to 9 m for the laying out of a driveway and parking area. The public meeting will be held at the Desjardins hall, located at 20, Chemin Raphaël in La Pêche and council will hear those who wish to comment on this application.
