Reduced Speed Limit

Please note that on September 6, 2016 the municipal council adopted by law 16-723, reducing the speed limit on Chemin Wakefield-Heights. The speed limit has been reduced to 40 km/h.

Recycling Foamed Polystyrene

Following a totally volunteer initiative, our local program for recycling foamed polystyrene products ("Styrofoam") has been running since January of last year and for this second year will be available on a regular basis. The company Styro Rail accepts CLEAN, WHITE AND FIRM (#6) foamed polystyrene pieces and uses them to manufacture recycled products. Centre Wakefield La Pêche, located at 38, Chemin de la Vallée-de-Wakefield, generously provides a container where the public may drop off their pieces of polystyrene foam. Volunteers sort out the items and deliver them to Styro Rail, thus ensuring that none of them end up in landfills where they can last for centuries.
