LA PÊCHE PASSIVHAUS TOWN HALL: A STATE-OF-THE-ART BUILDING

An increasingly popular word is circulating in La Pêche, the region and throughout Quebec: Passivhaus. The future La Pêche Town Hall is aiming for Passivhaus certification in 2024, the first institutional building in Canada to be Passivhaus-certified!

But what exactly is “Passivhaus?”

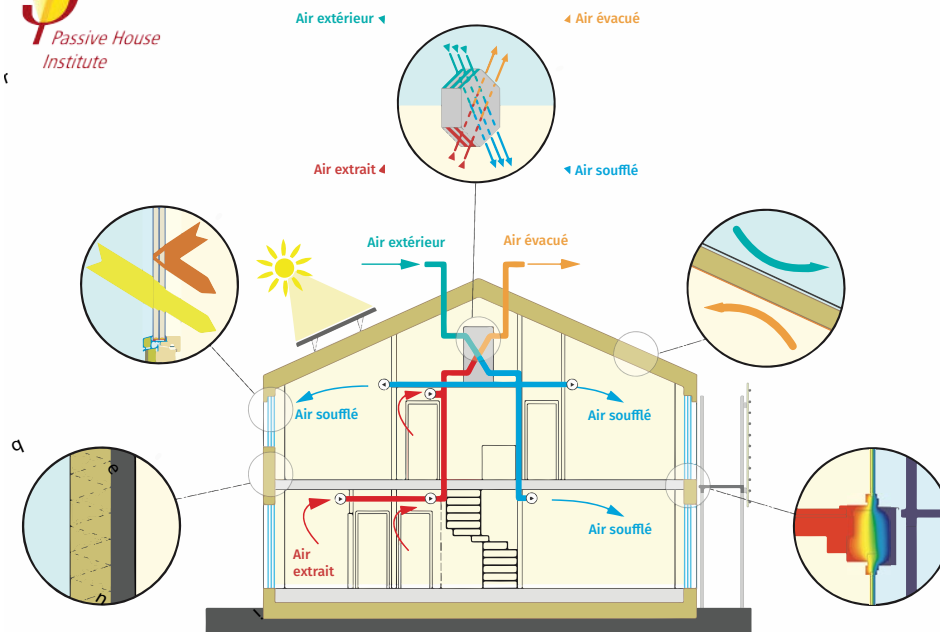
According to the project’s architects and engineers, acquiring this certification will result in **energy savings of 85%** compared with similar constructions prior to 2021, for all the building’s energy needs, including heating and cooling.

With its **outstanding insulation**, this reduction in energy demand will also cut mechanical equipment costs and electricity bills. The high-quality materials used will also extend the **building’s lifespan**.

Why is the entire structure including the roof made of wood? Wood is a carbon sink that **stores and regulates the amount of CO₂** in the environment. In addition to being sustainable, it requires little energy for its transformation into a building material, is locally available and provides a pleasant living environment for its occupants.

Every detail was meticulously considered at the design stage, from the length of the screws to the angle of the awnings. The awnings are designed to let in heat and sunlight in winter, but to provide shade in summer!

Let’s talk about the sawtooth roof with its **20 inch screws**—yes, you read that right, 20 inches! Each screw being a thermal bridge, the engineers and architects calculated the



exact minimum number needed for the structure. In fact, since the screws holding the roof’s top plywood are installed under the top membrane, the number had to be kept to a minimum, since the cold is transmitted by the screw from its head on the outside to the inside of the building. For maximum dimensional stability, they used cross-laminated timber (CLT), with a span of up to 18 metres per panel, without the need for columns or beams to support it all! This innovative wood structure will enable the floor to be rearranged to suit long-term needs. As a bonus, you’ll also benefit from the advantages of wood. The sawtooth roof is **a first in North America**, thanks to the innovative use of CLT!

The majestic, impressive windows have just been installed, and are well worth a closer look!

A WORD FROM THE MAYOR



Dear citizens of La Pêche,

As you probably know, on December 18, the Municipal Council adopted a resolution asking Minister Laforest to postpone the adoption of the 2024 budget. This decision was made in light of the shortage of personnel in the Finance Department. In fact, from April to September 2023, two managerial positions became vacant in this department. Fortunately, since September, we've had the great pleasure of working with two professionals who are performing outstanding work to make up for lost time and plan effectively for the coming fiscal years.

This year again, Quebec municipalities are faced with numerous challenges. The Board has made every effort to minimize the impact of inflation, rising municipal contract costs and interest rates on the taxpayers of La Pêche. **However, we have been careful to maintain our essential services, to continue catching up on overdue investments in our infrastructure and equipment, to pursue our environmental efforts and**

to continue supporting community organizations' initiatives. However, it is clear that the Council will have to review some of its existing ways of doing things in order to curb rising costs.

Changes are already taking shape in waste management: La Pêche is working with Cantley and Chelsea to set up an **intermunicipal service** to reduce costs. As for snow removal, we are seriously considering the possibility of returning to **in-house operations**. In terms of debt management, we are putting off some infrastructure projects to better distribute costs over time, as well as **maximizing opportunities to secure funding**. We have also introduced an internal financing method to reduce interest payments on

our debt.

In terms of taxation, the increases are still higher than desired. Under the circumstances, the Council has decided to **review taxation methods** so that cost-sharing is more closely based on property values. Tax payments will also be divided into **4 coupons over an extended period** until the end of October. The tax bill increase in 2024 for a single family with a median value home of \$290,300 amounts to an annual increase of \$208.14 compared with the previous year's rates. The change in the residential tax rate went from \$0.6202 to \$0.5740 for each \$100 of municipal property assessment.

All in all, compared with the regional

and provincial average rates provided by the Ministère des Affaires Municipales et de l'Habitation (MAMH), La Pêche continues to maintain an excellent financial profile.

MAYOR REPORT, FINANCIAL STATEMENT HIGHLIGHTS AND EXTERNAL AUDITOR'S REPORT 2022



Mayor Guillaume Lamoureux presented, during the Municipal Council meeting on Monday, October 2, 2023, the highlights of the 2022 financial report and the external auditor's report.

The 2022 financial year ended with an operating surplus for the year of \$286,840, resulting from revenues amounting to \$19,401,192, compared to expenses and allocations of \$19,114,353, as audited

by the external auditor thus bringing the unallocated surplus to \$1,222,282 as of December 31, 2022. Part of this surplus was allocated to the 2023 financial year and a balance of \$653,672 therefore remains available.

Achievements 2022

Of the total operating expenses of more than \$19 million, just under \$12.15 million consists of fees and obligations:

- MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais share: \$4.23 million
- Residual materials management contract: \$1.56 million
 - 1.07 million for garbage and recycling
 - 454 k\$ for compost (new service)
 - 50 k for bulky items
- Snow removal contract: \$1.46 million
- Contributions to various organizations: \$663 thousand
- Overall debt management: \$1.29 million
- Salaries including social charges: \$5.56 million

Although the year 2022 was marked by a lack of labour, the Municipality was still able to invest considerably in its infrastructure and equipment, in addition to taking big steps in achieving the objectives identified in the 2019–2023 Municipal Strategic Plan. Investment costs of \$4.5 million were made, including \$3.11 million for road works. The Municipality also received confirmations for obtaining more than \$1.53 million in non-recurring grants, including \$1 million from the Wood Construction Innovation Program for the future Passivhaus City Hall.

"Again this year I would like to highlight the work of all La Pêche volunteers. Although this report describes the financial situation of our organization, it does not include the invaluable contribution you have made to the well-being of our community. On behalf of the municipal council and all citizens,

I thank you for your continued commitment."—Guillaume Lamoureux, Mayor

According to the financial profile published on the website of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing, the long-term total net debt ratio of the \$100 of standardized property wealth is \$0.88, compared to the average ratio of the all the municipalities of the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais of \$1.72, that of the population class \$1.85 (population of 2,000 to 9,999 people), and that of the province of Quebec of \$2.16 (administrative region = \$1.47).

The financial report as of December 31, 2022, therefore demonstrates that your municipality is in an excellent financial situation.

NOTICE FOR CITIZENS

YOUR MUNICIPALITY, YOUR PRIDE!

As a citizen of La Pêche, you probably want to be able to look at beautiful landscapes, smell the fresh air, and stroll in full safety when you go for a walk. When we think of safety, we always think of children's safety as well. And you're probably proud to be able to show off your beautiful municipality to your friends and family! Unfortunately, some people throw their garbage, their household waste, just about anywhere instead of respecting municipal collection, or taking the waste to the transfer station on their own.

Our team found some debris at Complexe Sportif La Pêche. It's unsafe because it's accessible to children; this deplorable act is not only polluting, but it's also forbidden. This is not a first. Household hazardous waste (HHW) collections take place twice a year in La Pêche, to save residents the trip to the transfer station and to recycle as many items as possible. At no time has the Municipality designated the Complexe Sportif as a triage centre or transfer station.

All La Pêche residents are entitled to 6 free HHW deliveries per year, not exceeding a total of 100 kg, to the transfer station at 28 chemin La Pêche, Val-des-Monts (route 366). What's more, your tires, separated from their rims are accepted! Some bulky items as well! If in doubt or if you have any questions, call or e-mail us:

By-law 22RM04



SECTION 6—PROTECTION OF PUBLIC PROPERTY

6.1 It is prohibited to throw, deposit or spread on any public property, earth, paper, garbage, refuse, dead animals, demolition materials, liquid substances, as well as any movable property or any other substance of the same kind.

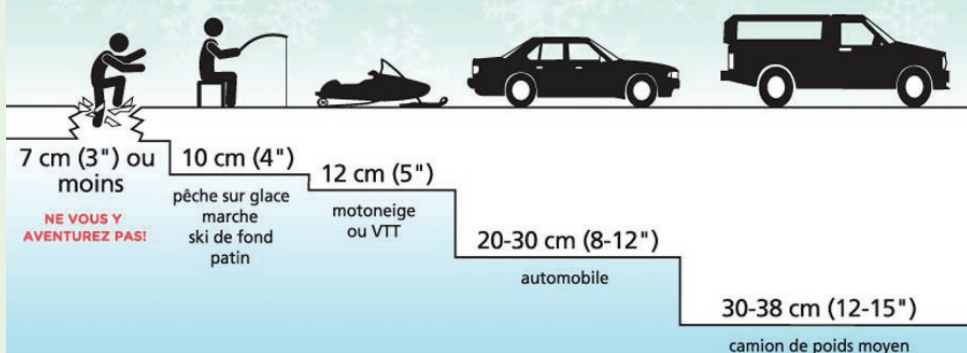

DO YOU KNOW OUR LUCIE?

Have you ever noticed the Halloween and Christmas decorations at the Town Hall? If so, you can thank the dedicated Lucie Groulx who has been working for the municipality for five years.

What's more, when the municipality had to donate wreaths that were too small to hang on lampposts, Lucie offered to use her personal decorations to refresh them. These 48 newly decorated wreaths were donated to the "Parade illuminée" in 2022 as a fundraiser, and it was a huge success.

Lucie also decorated the 28 new wreaths for the street lamps in the Wakefield and Sainte-Cécile-de-Masham areas,

once again with ornaments she had at home. With tremendous generosity and boundless passion, this is her way of spreading magic not only in the Municipality, but also in everyone at Town Hall.

DON'T START A FIRE!

Every year, **improper storage of hot ashes** causes an average of **140 building fires**. In most cases, statistics show that the container was unsuitable or that the storage was inadequate. This heat source is among the top 10 identified by firefighters when investigating the causes and contributing circumstances of a fire.

Safety first!

This can be prevented by regularly removing ashes from the firebox. Dispose of hot ashes in a metal container with a raised base and a metal lid. This container should be placed outside on a non-flammable surface. **Never use a vacuum cleaner to collect hot ashes!**

Other best practices:

- Put the container **at least one metre away** from the walls of your house, garage, garden shed or any other flammable material such as hedges or canvas shelters.
- Ashes should remain in this container for **at least 7 days** before being disposed of in any other container, such as the organic matter bin.
- Before transferring the ashes to any other type of container, make sure they **have completely cooled down**. Stir the ashes regularly to avoid heat build-up.



For added security, store the ashes throughout the winter and dispose of them in the spring.

Can you use these ashes on your property?

The fertilizing value of wood ashes as a substitute for agricultural lime and potassium and phosphorus-rich fertilizers is well known. But did you know that ashes can contaminate your soil, pollute water or even smother your home compost?

When spreading ashes, it is advisable

to spread them on **soils with a pH below 7**, and not to exceed a normal agronomic dosage of **0.15 kg/m²** per year. Basic precautions should also be taken during handling ashes to protect eyes and respiratory tract.

More tips:

1. Avoid adding fertilizers containing potassium, phosphorus or calcium.
2. Use only natural dry wood (do not use sea wood, treated wood, building materials, plastics, etc.).

3. Make sure you use high-temperature combustion; low-temperature combustion produces more organic contaminants.

It's important to dispose of ashes that have been contaminated by soot from chimney sweeping as these are toxic. **Be sure to let them cool for at least 7 days before throwing them in the garbage!**

CLIMATE CHANGE: INTEREST IS HIGH!

The "Commission municipale pour l'action sur les changements climatiques de La Pêche" would like to extend its heartfelt thanks to all those who participated in our consultation activities this fall.

Since September, **over a hundred people** have visited the Commission's travelling kiosk (present at events and high-traffic locations throughout the municipality), where visitors have shared their suggestions and voted on possible initiatives for La Pêche's climate action plan. The Commission received detailed briefs, suggestions, and recommendations by email from a range of organizations and individuals, totalling 25.

And then, on Thursday, November 9, 2023, at "Complexe Sportif La Pêche," 36 people took part in a consultation session when the mayor spoke about climate action initiatives already completed and underway within the municipality. Participants learned more about the Commission's mandate and shared some **150 suggestions and 350 votes** for actions for inclusion in the action plan.

In addition, during its mandate, the Commission



organized a pre-consultation session with La Pêche's environmental groups and met with several community experts and municipal staff. The Commission is grateful for the expertise shared by these groups and individuals.

The consultation process has come to an end, and the Commission is now preparing to analyze the results and go on to draft its recommendations.

Overall, the Commission was delighted with the high level of involvement in its activities. It observed a very high level of expertise in climate action within



our community, and greatly appreciated the many relevant and well-considered suggestions that were shared.

We thank you for your enthusiasm, commitment, and input to this process. And this is just the beginning - once the action plan has been developed and approved, your involvement in its implementation will be vital.
